**Vera Forte McCain Scholarship for Graduate Student Sorors**

Soror Vera Forte McCain was a member of Alpha Mu Omega chapter and an Indianapolis Public School teacher who, in 1990 left a generous bequest to the chapter. Two scholarships were established. One was for undergraduates which is administered in partnership with the Educational Advancement Fund and a second scholarship for Sorors of Alpha Mu Omega Chapter who are full time students pursuing their graduate degrees. Ivy Endowment, Incorporated currently administers the scholarship annually in the amount of \$1,000.00 in accordance to the recipient criteria established by Soror McCain.

**Scholarship Criteria.** A soror pursuing a graduate degree as a full-time student and who is an active member of Alpha Mu Omega Chapter may apply for this scholarship. A soror is only eligible to receive the Vera Forte McCain Scholarship once. To be considered, the soror must have a cumulative grade point application of 3.0 or above and complete the required application.

**Scholarship Amount.** Scholarships in the amount of \$1,000.00 will be sent directly to the university at which the scholarship recipient soror attends.

3. Submit a one-page, type written essay which describes your educational and career goals and why Ivy Endowment, Incorporated should award you a scholarship.
4. Submit a completed application by January 13, 2012.
